

EXPECTATIONS

The National Student Electronic Media Convention will be a lot of hard work and a learning experience. Just as with any professional, continuing education program, students participating in the CBI convention are expected:

- * to participate in all activities, scheduled and unscheduled;
- * to follow all university policies and state laws;
- * to realize that, while at this convention, they represent 89.1 The Point, The College at Brockport and themselves and should do so in a positive manner at all times; and
- * to be flexible since traveling with a group is always a challenge.

GOALS

While at the convention, students will:

- * attend educational sessions at each block from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Thursday, Friday and Saturday and summarize ideas, discoveries and thoughts to present to the Board of Directors and General Membership at the next meeting after returning back at school;
- * develop working relationships with other student media staff members;
- * visit the exhibit area to learn new ideas from various vendors; and
- * enjoy some of the sights and sounds of Seattle.

COSTS

89.1 The Point will pay for your conference registration fees (\$100/person), room (\$676/person) and flight (about \$435/person) equaling \$1,211.00. Students pay for their meals.

Should you leave the staff before the completion of the academic year, you will be responsible for reimbursing 89.1 The Point for the full cost of attendance. Also, should you violate college policy requiring your early departure from the conference, all travel costs and other financial obligations are your responsibility.

I understand that by signing my name below that, if I fail to comply with my responsibilities as a staff member for the 89.1 The Point, I will be required to reimburse the staff for the cost of the trip, approximately \$1,211. Further, I understand the expectations of me during the national convention.
