



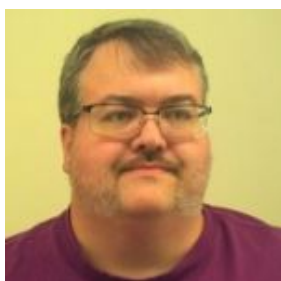
CBI wraps up Minneapolis convention
